

CHAPTER XLVIII.

February 28, 1866 *An Act to Define the Boundary Line of Chippewa county, and to provide for its organization.*

- SECTION 1.** Defines the boundaries and provides for organization.
2. Locates county seat.
 3. When act to take effect.
 4. Repeals all acts inconsistent with this.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The boundary line of Chippewa County is hereby established, and shall hereafter be as follows: Beginning in the middle of the main channel of the Minnesota River, on the range line between ranges thirty-six and thirty-seven; thence north to the northeast corner of township one hundred and nineteen; thence west to the northwest corner of said township one hundred and nineteen; thence north to the northeast corner of township one hundred and twenty-two of range thirty-eight; thence west to the northwest corner of township one hundred and twenty-two of range forty west; thence south to the centre of the main channel of the Minnesota river; thence down said river to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. The county of Chippewa is hereby declared an organized county, and the county seat thereof temporarily located at Chippewa City.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the ratification of the act entitled "An act to define the boundary line of Renville county, and to provide for its organization."

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
