

CHAPTER LX.

An Act appropriating money for the benefit of the State Library. March 1, 1866.

SECTION 1. Appropriates money for the benefit of the State Library.

1. Establishes contingent fund.
2. Appropriation for binding newspapers, &c.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated. Appropriates money for State Library.

1st. For contingent fund for State Library, one hundred and fifty dollars.

2d. For binding newspapers and arranging and printing catalogue of Library, one hundred and fifty dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
