How expenses to be paid.

SEC. 7. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road shall be paid by the counties through or in which said road shall run, in proportion to the distance it shall run in said county.

SEC. 8. This act shall take effect from and after

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners to be appointed.

SECTION 1. That J. A. C. Flood, T. H. Pendergast and David Alway are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and establish a State road from Watertown, in Carver county, by way of Hutchinson, in McLeod county, to Lake Preston in township No. 115 north, of range No. 31 west.

Place of meeting.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at Hutchinson, in McLeod county, on the third Monday in May next, and proceed to discharge their duties according to the provisions of this act.

SEC. 3. In case a majority of the above named vacancies—How rommissioners shall fail to convene on the day as pro-filed. vided in section two, it shall be the duty of the commissioner that may be in attendance on the day so specified, to appoint substitutes.

SEC. 4. The said commissioners are hereby empow- May appoint offi-

ered to employ a surveyor, two chainmen and one axe-

man.

Sec. 5. Said commissioners are hereby authorized Commissioners to adopt the survey of any portion of the State road may adopt surfrom Watertown to Hutchinson as now established. vey. They shall, on or before the first day of January, 1867. file in the auditor's office of the respective counties, a plat of the survey of such portions of said road as shall be re-located between Watertown and Hutchinson, together with a plat of the road from Hutchinson to Preston Lake.

Sec. 6. The said commissioners shall appraise the Appraisal of damages sustained by each owner of land through damages. which the said road shall pass, and shall file a certificate of such appraisal in the auditor's office of the respective counties, subject to appeal, as in the case of appraisal made by town supervisors.

SEC. 7. That each county through which said road counties to new shall pass shall pay the reasonable expenses incurred expenses. in surveying and laying out the same in such county.
