CHAPTER XI.

An act to authorize the Minnesota Central Railroad Company to construct a Branch Railroad from Faribault by the way of Kenyon, Zumbrota, Mazeppa and Zumbro Falls, to the Mississippi river.

- Secrecy 1. Minnesota Railroad Company authorized to construct a Branch Railroad from Faribault to the Mississippi.
 - 2. Defines the powers of said Railroad Company.
 - 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

May I ocate branch road. Section 1. That the Minnesota Central Railroad Company is hereby authorized and empowered to survey, locate, construct and maintain a new branch railroad, having its western terminus at the town of Faribault, on the existing line of said Minnesota Central Railroad, via Zumbro Falls, and thence down the main Zumbro river to such point upon the line of the Saint Paul and Winona Railroad as may be found feasible for a point of junction.

Powers of Com'y

- SEC. 2. For the purpose of surveying, locating, constructing and maintaining such branch railroad, the said Minnesota Central Railroad Company shall have all the powers, rights and privileges, and shall be subject to all the conditions and regulations by law granted or imposed upon the said company. *Provided*, That the Legislature hereby reserve the right to regulate the price of freights and fare upon said branch road.
- SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
