Receipt to act as SEC. 3. Upon the receipt of such *pro rata* share of such assets by any creditor, the same shall operate as a release on the part of the creditor so receiving the same of any further claim upon said administrators, or upon the estate of said deceased.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXIV.

March 1, 1888. An Act in relation to conveyances made by the excoutors and administrators of L. P. Wedge, deceased.

SECTION 1 Certain conveyances made valid.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Conveyances to be valid. SECTION 1. That all deeds and conveyances executed by any executor or administrator of the estate of L. P. Wedge, deceased, and the record thereof, are hereby legalized and made valid. And that A. D. Clark, the administrator, with the will annexed, of said estate, or any administrator with the will annexed, who may be hereafter appointed, shall have full power and authority to sell and convey at private sale or otherwise, any of the real estate of said deceased, as to such administrator shall seem to the best interests of the estate, and with the same power and authority as was conferred upon the original executors, by the testator in said will.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

Approved March 1, 1866.
