CHAPTER CXVI.

March 2, 1868. An Act to authorize Robert H. Jefferson, guardian, to sell and convey real estate.

SECTION 1. Sale of real estate, by guardian, authorized.

2. Guardian to account to Judge of Probate.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Guardian may sell. SECTION 1. That Robert H. Jefferson, appointed by the judge of probate of Ramsey county guardian of the person and estate of Harriet A. Jefferson, a minor and heir at law of Robert E. Jefferson, deceased, is hereby authorized and empowered, with the approval of the judge of probate of said county, to bargain, sell, grant and convey at public or private sale any or all of the real estate of which the said Robert E. Jefferson died seized, for such sum or sums of money, and on such terms as in his judgment may seem for the best interests of said ward.

To account.

SEC. 2. Said guardian shall account to said judge for all moneys received by him for said minor for such sales.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
