

CHAPTER XXXV.

March 1, 1888.*An act for the relief of School District number eight in Steele County.*

- Section 1.** County Auditor to furnish Clerk of school district with copy of assessment roll.
2. District Clerk to fill out assessment roll with tax on all taxable property in district.
 3. Treasurer—his powers and duties.
 4. Treasurer to make return to County Auditor.
 5. Duties of Auditor and Treasurer.
 6. How questions in dispute in reference to taxes are to be settled.
 7. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Duty of Auditor.

SECTION 1. The county auditor of the county of Steele shall immediately furnish the clerk of school district number eight, in said county, with a copy of the assessment roll of the property, real and personal, of said school district.

Duty of Clerk.

SEC. 2. The district clerk shall immediately fill out said roll with a tax upon all the taxable property of said district, for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as the district board may find necessary to pay the indebtedness of said district, and deliver the same to the treasurer of said district.

Powers of treasurer.

SEC. 3. The said treasurer shall immediately proceed to collect the same, and for this purpose the said treasurer is hereby invested with all the powers, rights and privileges which the county treasurer might or could be in case the same had been included and extended upon the tax roll now in his hands for collection.

Return to be made to Auditor.

SEC. 4. On or before the twentieth day of March next, the said district treasurer shall make return to the county auditor, of all amounts then remaining uncollected.

SEC. 5. After said return, the county auditor and

county treasurer shall proceed in all respects with such tax remaining unpaid, as they might or could have done had the same been properly included upon the tax roll now in said county treasurer's hands for collection. How collected.

Sec. 6. All questions between vendee and vendor relating to this tax, shall be determined in the same way that they would have been had the same been regularly extended upon the general tax roll of said county now in the hands of the county treasurer for collection. Disputed questions—how settled.

Sec. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXVI.

An act for the relief of school district number forty-five, in the County of Houston, and to authorize the County Auditor of said county to extend upon the tax roll for collection the taxes levied by the legal voters of said district in the year 1865. February 2, 1866

- SECTION 1. Duties of County Auditor of Houston County in reference to School District number forty-five.
2. County Treasurer to have power to collect all taxes levied for said school district.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county auditor be and he is hereby authorized, directed and required, on or before the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six (1866), to extend on the tax duplicate of Duty of County Auditor.
