

CHAPTER XLVII.

March 1, 1866. *An Act relating to school districts in the town of Pilot Mound, Fillmore County.*

SECTION 1. The town of Pilot Mound, Fillmore County, to be entitled to receive certain moneys on condition specified.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That any school district hereafter created out of any existing district in the town of Pilot Mound, in the county of Fillmore, in this State, shall be entitled after paying the debts of the district from the territory of which such district shall be created, to a division of all moneys in the treasury of the old district at the time of its division, and of all moneys accruing from taxes levied prior to such division, and of all public moneys apportioned to said district prior to said division, in proportion to the number of scholars in the new districts so created respectively.

All School Districts entitled to share of moneys.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
