

CHAPTER LVI.

An Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Morrison county to levy a tax for the purpose of building a bridge from the east bank of the Mississippi River to Mill Island, at or near the town of Little Falls, in said county.

February 6, 1866.

SECTION 1. County Commissioners of Morrison county authorized to levy tax for bridge.

2. Duties of County Auditor in reference to said tax.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the Board of County Commissioners of Morrison county are hereby authorized to levy on the taxable property of said county for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, the sum of three thousand dollars, to be expended by them, or under their direction, in building "a bridge from the east bank of the Mississippi River to Mill Island, to connect with the bridge from said Mill Island, to the west bank of the Mississippi River," in the town of Little Falls, in said county of Morrison.

Commissioners may levy tax for bridge.

SEC. 2. The Auditor of said county of Morrison is hereby directed to enter upon the tax books of said county for the year 1866, the amount of tax so authorized to be levied by the County Commissioners aforesaid, and the County Treasurer of said county of Morrison is hereby empowered and directed to collect said tax in the same manner as is prescribed by law for the collection of other county taxes.

Duties of Auditor

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
