

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act to annex a portion of the town of New Haven, in the county of Olmsted to the town of Kalmar in said county. January 22, 1866.

SECTION 1. Annexes portion of New Haven, Olmstead county, to town of Kalmar.

2. Town of New Haven to receive taxes.
3. How debts to be paid.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one, two and three of the legal subdivisions, according to government survey, now belonging to and being a part of the town of New Haven in the county of Olmsted, be and the same are hereby detached from said town of New Haven and annexed to and made part of the town of Kalmar in said county. Annexes two townships.

SEC. 2. All taxes heretofore levied upon said sections one, two and three shall be considered and shall be due and payable to the town of New Haven. When taxes to be payable.

SEC. 3. The said sections one, two and three shall for the purpose of paying any debt or debts heretofore contracted by the town of New Haven for the purpose of paying bounties to soldiers, be held as belonging to said town of New Haven, and may be taxed by the said town of New Haven for that purpose.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
