

CHAPTER LXXI.

An Act to authorize the County Auditor of Martin County to issue election certificates to the county officers of Jackson County. January 22, 1866.

- SECTIONS 1. Authorizes County Auditor of Martin County to issue election certificates.
 2. On receipt of certificates, persons entitled may discharge duties of officer.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The auditor of Martin county is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver proper certificates of election to such persons as shall appear from the returns made to his office to have received a majority of the votes cast at the last general election held in Jackson county, for the several county officers of said county. Duties of Auditor

SEC. 2. Upon receipt of said certificates, the persons entitled to the same are hereby fully empowered to discharge the duties of the offices to which they were respectively elected, until their successors are elected and qualified; and all their acts and proceedings done and had in conformity to the law prescribing the duties of county officers, are hereby ratified and declared legal. Certificate entitled holder to office.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
