CHAPTER LXXII.

Pedruary 28, 1868 An Act to attach certain sections of land in the town of Denmark, in Washington county, to the town of Cottage Grove, in said county.

SECTION 1. Attaches certain sections of land in the town of Denmark, in Washington county, to the town of Cottage Grove, subject to a vote of the electors.

- 2. How vote to be taken.
- B. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Certain land to be attached to Cuttage Grove. Section 1. That sections six (6), seven (7), eighteen (18) and nineteen (19), in town twenty-seven north of range twenty west, be and they are hereby attached to town twenty-seven north, of range twenty-one west, and shall hereafter constitute part and parcel of the town of Cottage Grove, in the county of Washington. *Provided*, That this proposition shall be submitted to the citizens of each of said towns, at the annual town meeting of April, 1866, and if approved by a majority of the votes cast in each of said towns, then the provisions of section one of this act shall take effect and be in force, otherwise to remain void.

Proposition to be voted on.

SEC. 2. The vote taken on the proposition in section one of this act shall be by ballot, by adding to the general town ticket the words, "For transfer of sections six, seven, eighteen and nineteen in Denmark to Cottage Grove," or "Against transfer," &c., as the case may be. *Provided*. That should such towns or either of them take no action in regard to the provisions of the first section of this act, such non-action shall be considered as an approval by said town or towns of the proposition set forth in said section.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
