

CHAPTER OIII.

March 9, 1867,

An Act to amend chapter sixteen of the General Statutes, relating to licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors.

SECTION 1.—Amends chapter 16 of general statutes referring to licenses.

2 —When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four of chapter sixteen of the general statutes, be amended by striking out the following words, in lines four and five of said section: "From which an intention to evade the provisions of this chapter appears," and by inserting in lieu thereof the following words: "shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and."

Amendment

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CIV.

An Act to amend section twenty-eight of chapter sixty-four, General Statutes, in relation to the terms of the district court in the fourth judicial district.

SECTION 1.—Specifies the periods at which terms of district court are to be held in the several counties in the fourth judicial district.

2.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty-eight, of chapter sixty-four of the general statutes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 28. In the fourth judicial district, in the county of Hennepin, on the first Tuesday in May and third Tuesday in November. In the county of Carver, on the third Tuesday in October and the third Tuesday in March. In the county of Meeker, on the second Tuesday in September. In the county of Wright, on the second Tuesday in April and the fourth Tuesday in September. In the county of Anoka, on the third Tuesday in December. In the county of McLeod, on the third Tuesday in September. Amendment

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER OV.

An Act to change the time of holding the District Court in the counties of Dakota, Olmsted and Houston. January 25, 1867.

SECTION 1.—When general term of court to be held in the several counties specified.

2.—How processes to be returnable from Dakota county.

3.—How from Olmsted county.

4.—How from Houston county.

5.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

6.—When act to take effect.
