

## CHAPTER OXI.

*An Act to amend section thirty of chapter sixty-four of the General Statutes, relating to the general terms of the District Court.* March 1, 1867

SECTION 1.—Amends chapter 64 of general statutes by adding certain words thereto.

2.—Where writs, etc., made returnable.

3.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

4.—When act shall take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section thirty of chapter sixty-four of the general statutes be and is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the following words: "In the county of Watonwan on the second Tuesday in October." Amendment

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to the district court of the county of Blue Earth, the cause or subject matter of which originated in the county of Watonwan, shall be considered and deemed returnable to the terms of such court in the county of Watonwan as are fixed by this act, and all continuances, and all motions made or taken to any term of the district court of said county of Blue Earth shall be deemed to be made or taken to the terms of such court as the same are fixed by this act, and all motions or other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of such court shall all be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of such court in the county of Watonwan as the same are fixed by this act. Where writs returnable

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
