

CHAPTER CXV.

An Act to amend section two of chapter three of the General Statutes, relating to apportionment. February 21, 1867

SECTION 1.—Amends section two of chapter three of general statutes—Defines what counties to compose third district—Apportionment of representatives.

2.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of section two of chapter three, general statutes, as relates to the apportionment of representation in the third district be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Amendment

The third district shall be composed of the counties of Stearns, Todd, Cass, Wadena, Otter Tail, Andy Johnson, Clay, Douglas, Becker, Polk, Pembina, Morrison, Crow Wing, Aiken, Itasca, Pope, Stevens, Traverse, Carlton, St. Louis and Lake, and shall be entitled to elect one senator and two representatives, of which number the county of Stearns shall be entitled to elect one, and the balance of the territory the other.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
