### CHAPTER XXXVIII.

Febru'ry 26, 1867

An Act to protect butter and cheese manufacturers.

SECTION 1.—Provides against adulterated milks and butter. 2.—When act shall take effect.

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota

Provides against adulteration

SECTION 1. Whoever shall knowingly sell, supply or bring to be manufactured to any butter or chees manufactory in this state, any milk diluted with water or in any way adulterated, or milk from which any cream has been taken, or milk commonly known a skimmed milk; or whoever shall keep back any par of the milk known as "strippings," or whoever shal knowingly bring or supply milk to any butter or chees manufactory that is tainted or partly sour from wan of proper care in keeping pails, strainers or any ves sel in which said milk is kept, clean and sweet, afte being notified of such taint or carelessness; or an cheese or butter manufacturer who shall knowingl use or direct any of his employees to use for his o their individual benefit, any cream from the mil brought to said cheese or butter manufacturer, with out the consent of all the owners thereof, shall, fo each and every offence, forfeit and pay a sum equal t twice the actual injury sustained by any person, firm association or corporation upon whom such fraud ma be committed, to be sued for in any court of compe tent jurisdiction, for the benefit of the person or per sons, firm or association or corporation or their assigns upon whom such fraud be committed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
