

## CHAPTER XLV.

*An Act to amend chapter eleven of the General Statutes, in relation to the publication of delinquent tax lists and notices.*

March 1, 1867

SECTION 1.—Regulates the publication of delinquent tax lists.

2.—When act shall take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and nineteen of chapter eleven of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

Amendment

*Section 119.* The county auditors shall cause the list of delinquent lands in their respective counties to be published at least three weeks, between the third Monday of March and the third Monday of May in each year, in some newspaper printed and published in their respective counties, the publisher of which shall agree to do the same at a price not exceeding the rates allowed by law, if any such is published therein, and if there is none such, then in a newspaper printed and published in an adjoining county, and if there be no such newspaper, then in a newspaper printed and published at the capital of the state; to which list there shall be attached a notice that the whole of the several tracts or town lots in said list contained, or so much thereof as shall be necessary to pay the taxes, penalty and expenses charged thereon, will be sold at the court house, in such county, or in case there be no court house, at such other place as may be determined upon by the county commissioners of said county, on the first Monday in June next thereafter, or on any subsequent day to which such sale may be lawfully adjourned by the county treasurer, unless such taxes; penalties and expenses are paid before that time.

Duty of county auditors

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
