

## CHAPTER XCIX.

February 9, 1867 *An Act to fix the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court.*

SECTION 1.—Fixes salaries of judges of supreme court.

2.—When salary begins.

3.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

4.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

salaries

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage of this act the salary of each of the judges of the supreme court shall be three thousand dollars per annum.

When to com-  
mence

SEC. 2. That the salary provided for in the preceding section shall begin with the year commencing January first, 1867.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
