man; Provided, Said commissioners shall receive three dollars per day for their services, the chainman and axeman shall not receive more than two dollars per day, nor the surveyor more than four dollars per day for their services under this act, which compensation shall be paid by the respective counties through which said road shall pass.

SEC. 4. Said commissionerrs shall on or before the Plats to be filed fifteenth day of November next, file an accurate map and plat of said road in the offices of the county auditors in the respective counties through which said road shall pass, and thereafter said road shall be deemed to

be located and established.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER OXXVI.

An Act to change a part of the State road running from March 9, 1867 Faribault, in Rice County, to Glencoe, in McLeod County.

SECTION 1.—Appoints three commissioners.

2.—Provides for organization.

3.-Plat to be fled.

4.-When road vacated.

b .- When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That William Smith, of LeSueur, and Commissioners John C. Stoever and Christian Didra, of Henderson, are hereby appointed commissioners to change that part of the Faribault and Glencoe state road which runs between Lesher's ferry, in LeSueur county, and the

borough of Henderson in Sibley county and establish and survey a road commencing at Lesher's ferry and running on the east side of the Minnesota river towards Henderson and connecting there with said state road.

Organization

Sec. 2. The said commissioners or a majority of them shall meet at Henderson before the first day of October next, and shall lay out, survey and open said part of said state road, and the expense for laying out and surveying said road shall be paid by the county of Sibley, on presentation of certificate of an account of said expense signed by two or all of said commissioners: *Provided*, That said expense shall not exceed twenty-five dollars.

Plat to be filed

SEC 3. The said commissioners shall, on or before the 1st day of November next, file with the auditor of LeSueur county, the map and field notes of the survey of said road, and on filing of the maps and field notes as aforesaid, the said road shall be deemed to be located and established.

When road va-

SEC. 4. As soon as said road is established that part of the Faribault and Glencoe state road which runs between Lesher's ferry and Henderson, in Sibley county, shall be considered vacated.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
