## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the guardians appointed by the Guardian may probate court of Ramsey county of the persons and sell real estate estate of William A. Findly, Mary B. Latour, Joseph Coursoll, jr., and Elizabeth Coursoll, minors, is hereby authorized and empowered, with the approval of the judge of probate of said county, to bargain, sell, grant and convey at public or private sale any or all the real estate of said minors, situate, lying and being in the state of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. Said guardians shall account to said judge To account to for all moneys received by them for said minors for indge such sale.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
