

CHAPTER OXLVI.

An act to change the name of the town of Wayzata to that of Freeport. March 9, 1867

SECTION 1—Changes name of town.

2—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Wayzata, in the county of Hennepin, be and is hereby changed to that of Freeport. Change of name

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

Approved March 9, 1867.

CHAPTER OXLVII.

An act to change the name of the street in the village of Anoka, known as "Territorial Road," to Main Street, in said village. March 1, 1867

SECTION 1—Name of street changed.

2—Duty of register of deeds in reference to said change.

3—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
