

## CHAPTER CLVI.

March 11, 1867

*An act to refund money to A. R. Field, expended in the search of the bodies of Capt. A. R. Field and Privates Fertile, Walker and Smith, of Co. "A." 2nd Minnesota Cavalry.*

SECTION 1.—Appropriation for benefit of A. R. Field.

2.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Appropriation

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to A. R. Field, out of any money that is or may be in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to repay him for money expended in the search for the bodies of Captain A. R. Field and Privates Fertile, Walker and Smith, of company "A," 2nd Minnesota regiment of cavalry, who were lost in the terrible storm on the plains on the 13th day of February, 1866.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
