CHAPTER XVI.

March 4, 1867.

An Act to authorize the Green Bay and Lake Pepin Railway Company to construct a Bridge across the Mississippi River.

SECTION 1.—Company authorized to build bridge.

2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Green Bay and Lake Pepin Railway Company is hereby authorized and empowered to build or construct a bridge at any point near the city of Wabashaw, Wabashaw county, state of Minnesota, across the Mississippi river, for the purpose of crossing the same with a railway track or tracks: *Providing* such bridge shall be so constructed with draws that the navigation of the river shall not be unnecessarily incommoded thereby.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
