

## CHAPTER XXXIV.

March 8, 1867. *An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act relating to the town of Lake City.*

SECTION 1.—Amends original act by giving additional powers.

2.—Board of supervisors empowered to lay out streets—compensation.

3.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Additional powers of council

SECTION 1. There shall be added to section one of said act and to the subdivision thereof the following:

*Fifteenth*—To license and regulate in their discretion the exhibition of common showmen and shows of all kinds, and the exhibition of caravans, circuses, concerts and theatrical performances, and also to license and regulate all auctions, billiard tables, pigeon-hole tables, nine or ten pin alleys, bowling saloons, pawnbrokers, taverns, saloons and all persons vending, dealing in or disposing of spirituous, vinous or fermented liquors.

*Sixteenth*.—To restrain and prohibit all descriptions of gaming and fraudulent devices and practices, all playing of cards, dice or other games of chance for the purpose of gaming, to restrain any person from vending, giving or dealing in spirituous, fermented or vinous liquors unless duly licensed by the board of supervisors.

*Seventeenth*.—To prescribe the limits within which wooden buildings or buildings of other materials that shall not be considered fire proof, shall not be erected, placed or repaired, and to direct that all and any buildings within the limits prescribed shall be made and constructed of fire-proof materials, and to prohibit the repairing or building of any wooden buildings within the fire limits when the same shall have been damaged to the extent of fifty per cent. of the value thereof, and to prescribe the manner of ascertaining such damage.

*Eighteenth.*—To provide a suitable place for the safe keeping of all persons arrested for any cause until they are discharged by due process of law or committed to the county jail.

SEC. 2. Amend section fourteen of said act by adding after the word "act" in the fifth line the following: "And are hereby authorized and empowered to lay out a street fifty feet wide through block one (1) in the village of Lake City to connect with Marion street and provide, by levying a tax, for the payment of all damage to the owners of lots or parts of lots therein damaged thereby, or in lieu of such compensation lease to said owners or their assigns, for a period of time not exceeding ninety-nine years, or so long as said street shall be used by the public as such, so much of the levee adjoining said block one (1) and block twelve (12) as to them shall seem just so that the same shall not seriously affect or injure said levee. Said board of supervisors and town clerk shall receive each for their services two dollars per day for the time actually employed in the discharge of their duties under this act." May lay out streets

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XXXV.

*An Act to authorize the Board of Supervisors of the township of Lake City, in the county of Wabasha, and State of Minnesota, to issue bonds.* March 9, 1867.

SECTION 1.—Authorizes board of supervisors to issue bonds.

2.—Board may levy special tax to pay interest, etc.

3.—Bonds—how denominated—how signed—duties of clerk in reference thereto

4.—How bonds negotiated—rate of interest.
