That the town board of the town of Featherstone, in the county of Goodhue, and state of Board may issue Minnesota, be and they are hereby authorized to issue orders to the treasurer of said town for the payment, out of the residue of the moneys raised by a tax upon the taxable property in said town and levied in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six for contingent expenses after paying such contingent expenses, of any or all other accounts audited and allowed by the town board of said town so far as such moneys will pay the same.
