CHAPTER LIV.

An Act to authorize the town of Cottage Grove, in the county of Washington, to raise funds by tax to erect a monument in memory of the soldiers from that town who fell in the suppression of the Great Rebellion.

SECTION 1.—Authorizes town of Cottage Grove to levy tax for certain purpose.

2.—Tax to be voted on.

5.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Town may levy

SECTION 1. That the town of Cottage Grove, in the county of Washington, is hereby authorized to levy and collect a tax upon the taxable property of the town, not to exceed the sum of one thousand dollars, for the purpose of erecting a monument to the memory of the soldiers from that town who fell in the war against the Southern Rebellion.

How tax | voted

SEC. 2. Said tax shall be voted and the amount determined in the same manner as is provided by law for levying and collecting taxes for township purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
