

CHAPTER LXVI.

An Act to amend section 46 of an act of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, entitled An Act to incorporate certain towns in this Territory and provide for town governments within the same, approved May 19, 1857.

SECTION 1.—Amends territorial incorporation act of 1857.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 46 of the act entitled "an act to incorporate certain towns in this territory and provide for town governments within the same," approved May 19, 1857, be amended by adding the following thereto, to wit: That a majority of the town council shall constitute a quorum to do business; that such quorum shall have power to appoint their president, secretary or clerk, and treasurer; that said corporation shall have power to acquire title to the lands named in said section 46, together with and including all the legal subdivisions within which said survey was made, not exceeding 320 acres, and shall convey the same in lots and parcels to the owners and occupants in severalty, according to their several rights and interests as provided by law; that each person interested shall be liable to pay his proportion of all proper and necessary expenses incurred by the corporation in the execution of its trust, excepting the money paid in the purchase of said land, on delivery of the conveyance, and such proportion may be levied and assessed upon the lots of such delinquent, certified by the secretary to the county auditor of Saint Louis county, by him to be placed upon the tax books of said county, and such levy and assessment shall be by the county treasurer of said county collected as other taxes, and by said treasurer paid over to the treasurer of said corporation.
