

## CHAPTER LXXX.

*An Act legalizing the levying of a tax of fifteen (15) mills by the board of commissioners of Martin county at the September session of 1866.* March 7, 1867

SECTION 1.—Legalizes action of commissioners.

2.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of commissioners of Martin county at the September session of 1866, levying a tax of fifteen (15) mills on the dollar to cancel the indebtedness of the county, represented by floating orders, is hereby declared legalized. Legalizes action of county

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXXI.

*An Act to authorize the several county officers of Monongalia county to hold their offices at their respective residences in said county.* February 14, '67

SECTION 1.—Where county officers to hold their respective offices.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The several county officers of Monongalia county shall hold their respective offices at their respective residences in said county. Tenure of office
