CHAPTER LXXXII.

February 21, 1867

An Act in relation to taxes in Monongalia county.

- SECTION 1.—Legalizes assessment and valuation of 1866.
 2.—Legalizes action of county auditor.
 3.—Extends time of payment of taxes.
 4.—Duty of county treasurer.
 5.—Delinquent tax sale—where held.
 6.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Assessment legalized

SECTION 1. That the assessment and valuation for taxation of property, real and personal, made by the several assessors in the county of Monongalia for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, be, and the same are hereby legalized and made valid.

Levy made valid

SEC. 2. That the levy of taxes made by the county auditor of said county upon the real and personal property therein, in and for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, be, and the same is hereby legalized and made valid in all respects.

Time of collect'n

SEC. 3. That the time for the collection and payment of all taxes for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six in said county, be, and the same is hereby extended to the first day of April next: *Provided*, That no penalty on account of the non-payment of any taxes in said county shall attach prior to the first day of April next.

SEC. 4. That between the first and the fifth day of

April next the county treasurer of said county shall return to the auditor of said county a list of all lands in said county upon which the taxes of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six shall remain unpaid, and the auditor of said county shall cause said list (with a notice attached thereto as required by law) to be published for four weeks successively prior to the first Monday in June next, in a newspaper published at Saint Cloud, in the county of Stearns.

Duty of treasurer and auditor

SEC. 5. That the delinquent tax sale for the taxes of the year eighteen hundred [and] sixty-six shall be held at the office of the county auditor of said county at the time and in the manner provided by law.

When tax sale held

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXIII.

An Act to legalize certain acts of the county officers of Pope county and authorize said officers to keep their several offices at the town of Glenwood, in said county.

March 8, 1867

SECTION 1.—Legalizes action of retaining office.

2.—Authorizes officers to further retain office.

3.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts of the county officers of Pope county in keeping their several offices at Glenwood, in said county, are hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. That the county officers of Pope county are hereby authorized to keep their several offices at Glenwood, in said county, until the county seat thereof is permanently established according to law, not
