April next the county treasurer of said county shall return to the auditor of said county a list of all lands Duty of treasurin said county upon which the taxes of the year one er and auditor thousand eight hundred and sixty-six shall remain unpaid, and the auditor of said county. shall cause said list (with a notice attached thereto as required by law) to be published for four weeks successively prior to the first Monday in June next, in a newspaper published at Saint Cloud, in the county of Stearns.

SEC. 5. That the delinquent tax sale for the taxes when tax sale of the year eighteen hundred [and] sixty-six shall be held held at the office of the county auditor of said county at the time and in the manner provided by law.
