

## CHAPTER XCII.

*An Act to legalize certain conveyances made by the county commissioners of Stearns county.* February 6, '67

SECTION 1.—Legalizes certain acts of county commissioners.

2.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all conveyances of real estate heretofore made by the board of county commissioners of the county of Stearns, and the records of said conveyance be and the same is hereby legalized and made valid for all intents and purposes. Legalizes certain conveyances

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XCIII.

*An Act to legalize certain records made by the Register of Deeds of Stearns county for land in Douglas county.* February 8, 1867

SECTION 1.—Legalizes certain acts of register of deeds.

2.—Power of register of deeds.

3.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

4.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

Legalizes certain records

SECTION 1. That the record of all conveyances and instruments of writing concerning real estate within the county of Douglas, in this state, which have heretofore been recorded by the register of deeds of the county of Stearns, in this State, is hereby legalized and shall have the same force and effect as if recorded in the said county of Douglas.

Duty of register of deeds

SEC. 2. That the register of deeds of the said county of Stearns is hereby authorized and empowered to file and record all such instruments of writing and conveyances as are mentioned in the first section of this act, in books separate and apart from the records of said county of Stearns, which said books, upon payment by said county of Douglas to said county of Stearns of the amount paid therefor by said county of Stearns, shall become the property of said county of Douglas; *Provided*, That the authority of the register of deeds of said county of Stearns to file and record the instruments of writing and conveyances heretofore mentioned shall cease and determine from the date that a demand is made by said county of Douglas for said books, and tender of the amount paid therefor by said county of Stearns.

Repeals inconsistent acts

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
