

CHAPTER CLX.

An Act to establish and prescribe the boundaries of certain counties therein named.

March 6, 1868.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county of Stevens is established and bounded as follows: Beginning at the north east corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty-one (41) west, of the fifth principal meridian, thence west to the north west corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty-four (44) west, thence south to the south west corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range forty-four west, thence east to the south east corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range forty-one (41) west, thence to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. The temporary county seat is hereby established at Gager's Station, on the south east quarter of section number twelve (12), in township (125) one hundred and twenty-five north, of range forty-two (42) [west.]

County seat.

SEC. 3. The county of Traverse is established and bounded as follows: Beginning at the north east corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty-five (45) west, to the western boundary of the state, thence south along the said boundary of the state to the intersection of the township line between townships one hundred and twenty-two (122), and one hundred and twenty-three (123), thence east to the south east corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of

range forty-five (45) west, thence north to the place of beginning.

County seat.

SEC. 4. The temporary county seat is hereby established at Traverse post office.

Boundary lines

SEC. 5. The county of Grant is established and bounded as follows: Beginning at the north east corner of township one hundred and thirty (130) north, of range forty-one (41) west, thence west to the north west corner of township one hundred and thirty (130) north, of range forty-four (44) west, thence south to the south west corner of township one hundred and twenty-seven (127) north, of range forty-four (44) west, thence east to the south east corner of township one hundred and twenty-seven (127) north, of range forty-one (41) west, thence to the place of beginning.

County seat.

SEC. 6. The county seat is hereby temporarily located on the south west quarter of section thirty-one (31), in township one hundred and thirty nine (139) north, of range forty-two (42) west.

SEC. 7. The within named counties are each severally attached to Pope county for record and judicial purposes, except Grant county, which is hereby attached to Douglas county for record and judicial purposes.
