This act shall take effect and be in force from Whenacttotake and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXI.

An Act to appropriate money for the State Library and March 5, 1868. Minnesota Historical Society.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the State Library and Minnesota Historical Society.

- 1. For draining basement of State Capitol.
- 2. For fitting up room in the basement under State Library room.
- 3. For fitting up room in the basement under Governor's room.
- 4. For Postage, Stationery, &c.
- 5. For Books for the State Library.
- 6. For incidental expenses, Historical Society.
- 2. By whom sums specified in the several subdivisions to be expended—to report to the Legislature.
- 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are here- Appropriation by appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury be- for State Libralonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appro- oal Society. printed, for the purposes herein specified.

First—For draining the basement of the state capitol, the sum of five hundred dollars.

Second—For fitting up the room in the basement under the state library room for the state library, and connecting the two rooms by a stairway, the sum of four hundred dollars.

Third—For fitting up the room in the basement under the governor's room in the state capitol for the library of the Minnesota historical society, four hundred dollars.

Fourth—For postage, stationery, furniture and other

incidental expenses in the state library, three hundred and fifty dollars.

Fifth—For books for the state library, five hundred

dollars.

Sixth—For incidental expenses of the Minnetota historical society, five hundred dollars.

By whom expended-to make report. SEC. 2. The several sums specified in the first, second and third subdivisions of section one of this act, shall be expended under the direction of the governor of the State who shall make a detailed report of his action herein to the legislature at its next session. The sum specified in the fifth subdivision of said section one shall be expended by the state librarian under the direction of the judges of the supreme court of the state. The sum specified in the sixth subdivision of said section one shall be expended under the direction of the executive council of said historical society, who are hereby required to report the manner of the expenditures together with vouchers therefor, and a detailed statement of the condition and operations of said society to the governor, to be laid by him before the legislature at its next session.

When act to take effect.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
