CHAPTER II.

An Act to regulate the number of Directors of the State February 1, 1868 Normal Board of Instruction.

- SECTION 1. State Normal Board of Instruction to consist of seven directors, one from each Judicial District-Superintendent of Public Instruction Secretary of said Board.
 - 2. Directors to be elected in accordance with the provisions of Section 7, Chapter 37, of the General Statutes.
 - 3. Repeal of all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The state normal board of instruction shall consist of seven directors, one from each judicial district, Instruction—of and the state superintendent of public instruction, who is whom to consist ex officio a member thereof, and is secretary of said board.
