GENERAL LAWS

CHAPTER XXV.

March 4, 1868.

An Act to amend an act for organizing, arming and disciplining the Militia of the State of Minnesota, approved March six, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

SECTION 1. All copies of records, certified and authenticated under the real of the Apjutant General, shall be evidence in all cases as if the originals were produced.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Scal of the office of Adjutant General. SECTION 1. That the scal now used in the office of the adjutant general shall continue to be the scal of his office, and shall from time to time be delivered to his successors in office, and all copies of records or papers in his office duly certified and authenticated under the said seal, shall be evidence in all cases in like manner as if the originals were produced.

When act to take effect.

totake SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
