

CHAPTER XXXVII.

*An Act prescribing and defining the further duties of
County Auditor.*

March 5, 1868.

- SECTION 1. County Auditors to make out and transmit to Town Clerks a certified copy of real estate assessment roll as equalized, biennially.
2. To transmit annually to Town Clerks a certified statement showing the amount of debt and credit existing between Town and County.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Each county auditor shall on or before the first Tuesday of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and biennially thereafter make out and transmit to the town clerk of each town in his county, a certified copy or abstract of the real estate assessment roll of said town as equalized by county and state boards of equalization.

SEC. 2. The county auditor of each county shall on or before the fifteenth day of March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, and annually thereafter, make and transmit to the town clerk of each town in his county, a certified statement showing the debt and credit existing between said town and county, under the several distinct and appropriate heads of taxation. And all moneys that the auditor shall receive as fees for services outside of his salary, he shall return to the county treasurer under oath.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
