Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section forty-eight (48), of chapter thirteen (13), of the general statutes of this state, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Supervisors to damages—town to pay the same.

The amount of damages as finally settled Sec. 48. by the county commissioners, or as agreed on by the and the charges of officers and other persons employed in laying out, altering or discontinuing any road, shall be audited by the supervisors with the amount of damages and charges due each individual, which amount shall be certified to, and deposited with the town clerk, and paid by the town; and before any road shall be opened or used, an amount of town orders equal to the damages assessed to each individual, shall be duly issued and deposited with the said clerk for the use of said individual, and shall be by said clerk delivered to him upon demand. The issuing and depositing of said orders as aforesaid shall be deemed to be sufficient secugity for the payment of said damages.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
