## CHAPTER LXIV.

Februa'y 18,1868

An Act to amend section ten, of chapter forty, of the General Statutes, relating to the execution of deeds in foreign countries.

BEUTION 1. Amendment to Section 10, Chapter 40, General Statutes. Deeds duly soknowledged not to be affected by laws of foreign countries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ten (10), of chapter forty (40), of the general statutes, be and the same hereby is amended by adding to said section as follows:

Laws of foreign countries not to affect deeds.

Provided, That any such deed duly signed and sealed with two witnesses, and acknowledged as aforesaid, shall be deemed good and sufficient whether in accordance with the laws of such foreign country or not.

## CHAPTER LXV.

March 6, 1868.

An Act to amend section nineteen (19), of chapter fiftyseven (57), of the general statutes, relating to sale of lands by executors, administrators and guardians.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 19, Chapter 57. Executors and administrators appointed in another State may file copy of appointment.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section nineteen (19), of chapter fifty-

seven (57), of the general statutes, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 19. An executor or administrator appointed in another state, upon whose estate there is no executor or administrator appointed in this state, may file an authenticated copy of his appointment in the probate court when executors for any county in which there is real estate of the de-appointment. ceased; after which he may be licensed by the same probate court to sell real estate for the payment of debts, legacies, and charges of administration, in the same manner and upon the same terms and conditions as are prescribed in the case of an executor or administrator appointed in this state, except as hereinafter provided. And such foreign executor or administrator may act by his attorney in fact thereto by him duly appointed under his hand and seal, and executed and acknowledged in the same manner as is required for the conveyance of real estate, which power of attorney shall be recorded in the office of the register of deeds for the county in which the real estate is situated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
