

## CHAPTER LXXII.

*An Act to amend section two hundred and seventy-nine (279), of chapter sixty-six (66), of the General Statutes, relating to civil actions.*

February 7, 1868

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 279, Chapter 66, General Statutes. Sewing machine exempt from execution.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section two hundred and seventy-nine, of chapter sixty-six, of the general statutes, be amended by adding the following clause to the enumeration of articles exempted from execution ;

Ninth—One sewing machine.

SEC. 2. This shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXIII.
