SEC. 9. That section twenty-tour is amended by ad-

ding the following words to said section:

And the council shall have power to issue orders on the Authorized to borough treasurer or certificates of indebtedness for any for what purpublic works, which may be necessary, and such orders or pose. certificates shall be signed by the mayor and clerk of the borough, and shall bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent. per annum until paid, and when so duly issued for labor performed or material furnished, said orders or certificates shall be received for any borough taxes, or when presented to the borough treasurer shall be paid by him out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated; Provided, That said orders or certificates shall not exceed the amount of one thousand dollars in any one year.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXIX.

An Act transferring a part of the territory of Minneapolis March 6, 1868. to Richfield, in Hennepin county, and for submitting the same to said towns.

SECTION 1. Boundary lines of the territory to be transferred.

2. To be submitted to legal voters of said towns—ballots, how prepared.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the territory described in this section to wit: the sections sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, Boundary Bnes twenty and twenty-one, of township one hundred and of the territory to be transferseventeen north, of range twenty-one west; and sections red. one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve, of township twenty-eight north, of

range twenty-four west; and sections six and seven, and so much of sections five and eight, as lie west of the centre, of the Mississippi River, and so much of section eighteen as lies north of the Minnehaha Creek, and so much of section seventeen as lies north of Minnehaha Creek and west of the Mississippi River, all in township twenty-eight north, of range twenty-three west, in Hennepin county, be and the same is hereby disannexed from the town of Minneapolis, and annexed to the town of Richfield in said county.

Sec. 2. At the next annual town meeting held in the towns of Minneapolis and Richfield, the legal voters of each of said towns may vote upon the proposition of transferring a part of the town of Minneapolis to Richfield, in said Hennepin county. The manner of voting upon said proposition shall be by ballot. The form of the ballot to be cast by those favoring said proposition, shall be "For transferring a portion of Minneapolis to Richfield," and the form of the ballot to be cast by those opposed to said proposition, shall be "Against transferring a portion of Minneapolis to Richfield." If the majority of the votes cast in each and both of said towns, shall be "For transferring a portion of Minneapolis to Richfield," then the first section of this act, shall take effect and be in force from and after the day of such vote, and if a majority of such ballots in either of such towns, shall be "Against transferring a portion of Minneapolis to Richfield," then said section one of this act, shall not become operative or of any effect.
