

## CHAPTER XLV.

*An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Mankato," approved March second, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.* February 23, 1868

SECTION 1. Boundary lines of the Village of Mankato.

2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Mankato," approved March second, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, be amended so as to read as follows, to wit:

Sec. 1. That all of the following described lands to wit: Lot one, and the south half of the south east quarter of section six; lots one, two, three and four and the south west quarter of the south east and the east half of the south east quarter and the east half of the north east quarter of section seven; and the south west quarter of the north west quarter and the west half of the south west quarter of section eight; and the west half of the north west quarter of section seventeen; and the north east quarter and the north west quarter and the north half of the south east quarter and the west half of the south west quarter and the north east quarter of the south west quarter of section eighteen; all in township one hundred and eight north, of range twenty-six west, and lots three, four and five, and the south half of the north east quarter and the south half of the north west quarter and the south west quarter and the north east quarter of section thirteen; and lots eleven, twelve and thirteen of section fourteen; all in township one hundred and eight north, of range twenty-seven west, in the county of Blue Earth, and state of Minnesota, shall be known as the village of Mankato, and by that name may sue and be sued, make contracts, purchase, take and hold, real and personal property, and may

have a corporate seal, alterable at pleasure. Every grant or devise of lands or right or transfer of property which has been or may be made for the benefit of its inhabitants, shall have the effect as if made to the village by name.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts relating to the village charter of Mankato, inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval.

## CHAPTER XLVI.

*An Act to Amend the several acts relating to the Incorporation of the Town of Fond du Lac in the County of St. Louis.*

February 27, 1868

SECTION 1. When annual election to be held for Town Officers—powers and duties of the Board of Trustees.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the qualified electors of the town of Fond du Lac in the county of St. Louis, shall on the third Tuesday in March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, and annually thereafter meet at the usual place of holding elections in said town, the electors present to select viva voce two judges and two clerks of said election, and upon the organization of such elective board, proceed to elect by ballot three trustees of said town, who shall hold their office until successors are elected and qualified. That the trustees so elected shall be the successors of the trustees of said town, appointed under the provisions of section forty-six of an act to incorporate certain towns and to provide for town governments within the same, approved
