

CHAPTER XLIX.

March 3, 1868. *An Act to attach the village of Chattanooga to, and make it a part of the village of Saint Charles, and to change the name Chattanooga to that of Saint Charles.*

SECTION 1. Attached and made a part of the Village of St. Charles.

2. All lots and blocks to be considered as lots and blocks in Birge's Addition to St. Charles.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the village of Chattanooga, in the town of Saint Charles, county of Winona, be and is hereby attached to, and made a part of the village of Saint Charles, and shall hereafter be known and described as "Birge's Additions" to the village of Saint Charles, as provided for in section two of this act.

SEC. 2. All lots and blocks in the first original plat of said village of Chattanooga, as recorded in the office of register of deeds in said county, shall be known and described as lots and blocks in "Birge's Addition" to the village of Saint Charles. All lots in "Birge's Addition" to the village of Chattanooga, shall be known and described as lots in "Birge's Second Addition" to the village of Saint Charles. All lots in "Birge's Second Addition" to the village of Chattanooga, shall be known and described as lots in "Birge's Third Addition" to the village of Saint Charles.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
