CHAPTER LX.

March 4, 1868.

An Act to detach certain territory from the independent school district of the town of Dover, county of Olmsted, and attach it to and make it a part of Saint Charles school district in the town of Saint Charles, county of Winona.

SECTION 1. Description of land to be detached.

- 2. Duty of Clerk of District where tax voted to be levied.

SEC. 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Description of land to be detached. SECTION 1. That the east one-half (1) of sections thirteen (13), twenty-four (24) and twenty-five (25), in the independent school district of the town of Dover, in the county of Olmsted, is hereby detached from said district, and attached to and made a part of Saint Charles school district, in the town of Saint Charles, and county of Winona.

When a tax is voted by said Saint Charles

school district, the clerk of said district shall transmit to the county auditor of each of the counties of Olmsted and Winona, a statement of the amount so voted. The said auditors shall thereupon transmit each to the other an abstract of the assessment in that part of the district in their respective counties, and shall levy the amount required in proportion to the amount of property in that part of the

respective counties, and shall levy the amount required in proportion to the amount of property in that part of the district situated in their respective counties. The money arising from such assessment shall be drawn by the treasurer of said Saint Charles school district from the county treasurer of such county in which said district is situated. The number of scholars in each fraction of said district shall be returned to the county auditor of the county of Winona, and all moneys apportioned shall be drawn by said district in the same manner as if said district was in the county of Winona.

This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER LXI.

An Act to attach certain territory to the St. Charles school March 4, 1863. district, in the county of Winona.

SECTION 1. Description of territory to be attached.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section thirty-one (31), in township one hundred and six (106) north, range ten (10) west, in Territory to be the town of Saint Charles, county of Winona, is hereby attached to and made a part of St. Charles school district, in said town and county.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from effect.
