

CHAPTER LXVII.

An Act to repeal chapter one hundred and one, special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven. March 4, 1868.

- SECTION 1. Repeal of former chapter.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and one, of special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, being an act to create an independant school district in Olmsted county, is hereby repealed. Repeal of former Chapter.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act to change the boundaries of the school district of the village of Oronoco Olmsted county. March 3, 1868.

- SECTION 1. Description of territory detached.
2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The territory described as the northeast

quarter of the northeast quarter, of section number thirty (30), town one hundred and eight (108) north, range fourteen (14) west; in the county of Olmsted, and embraced within the limits of the school district of the village of Oronoco, organized under the provisions of an act entitled "An act to organize a board of education for the village of Oronoco," approved March first, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, be and the same is hereby detached from said district, and placed under the control and supervision of the board of county commissioners of said county of Olmsted, and subject to the action of said board under the general statutes relating to common schools.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIX.

March 5, 1868.

An Act to abolish the independent school district, in the township of Dover, in the county of Olmsted.

SECTION 1. School district abolished.

2. To be submitted to the legal voters of said town—when township may become an independent district.
3. When said school district to be deemed abolished.
4. Election, how conducted—ballots, how prepared.
5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

School district abolished.

SECTION 1. That the independent school district, consisting of the township of Dover, in the county of Olmsted, is hereby abolished.
