

thousand dollars, for the purpose of furnishing the school house with the necessary furniture and meeting the present indebtedness of the district.

At what rate of interest—when payable.

SEC. 2. Such bonds shall be signed by the president and clerk of the board of education, and shall bear interest at the rate of twelve percent. per annum, payable annually; said bonds to be payable within three years from the date of issue.

Tax for paying principal and interest.

SEC. 3. A tax shall be levied on the property in said district each year, to pay the principal and interest falling due on said bonds.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER LXXIII.

February 14, 1868

*An Act to legalize the acts and proceedings of the voters and officers of School District number seven (7), in the County of Wright.*

- SECTION 1. All proceedings had by the voters of said school district are hereby legalized and made valid.
2. All proceedings of the officers of said school district are hereby legalized and made valid.
  3. All orders and certificates of indebtedness issued by the officers of said district are hereby legalized.
  4. All taxes levied on the taxable property of said district are hereby legalized.
  5. All acts of the Auditor and Treasurer in regard to such taxes are hereby legalized.
  6. How taxes collected.
  7. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all acts or proceeding had or done by the voters of school district number seven (7), in the

county of Wright, at their several meetings held in the month of April, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867), in pursuance of public notice or in pursuance of any adjournment, be and the same are hereby legalized and in all respects made valid. Proceedings of voters legalized.

SEC. 2. That the acts and proceedings of the officers of said district number seven (7) had or done in pursuance of the acts and proceedings of the said meetings or either of them, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid. Proceedings of officers legalized.

SEC. 3. That all orders and certificates of indebtedness issued by the officers of said school district, or a majority of them, as under their direction or the direction of a majority of them in pursuance of any vote or resolution of the said meetings, or either of them, be and the same are hereby legalized. Orders of indebtedness legalized.

SEC. 4. That all and singular, the taxes levied upon the taxable property of said district for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867), in pursuance of any resolution or vote of said meetings or either of them, and the assessment of such taxes, and of the property upon which the same was levied, be and the same are hereby legalized. All taxes legalized.

SEC. 5. That all acts of the auditor and treasurer of said county, in regard to such taxes and assessments, be and the same are hereby legalized. Acts of Auditor and Treasurer legalized.

SEC. 6. The said taxes shall be collected in the same manner, in all respects, as state and county taxes are collected; *Provided*, That no irregularity or informality in the proceedings or acts of the said county auditor or treasurer in relation thereto, heretofore or hereafter occurring, shall be deemed to vitiate or invalidate any acts or proceedings in reference thereto. How taxes collected.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
