Eastman, as trustees for the construction of the aforesaid improvements, as required and called for by them for the purposes of this act, and such bonds shall be made payable to them or bearer. *Provided*, Nothing in this act shall be construed to require or to authorize the city of Minneapolis to furnish the thirty-one thousand five hundred dollars in bonds referred to in this act except in proportion as the city of St. Anthony shall furnish the eight thousand five hundred dollars in bonds referred to in this act or said proportion is paid by individuals in cash for and instead of being paid in bonds by said city of St. Anthony.

### CHAPTER LXXXIII.

*An Act to enable the city of Minneapolis to assist in the preservation of Falls of St. Anthony.*

March 6, 1868.

SECTION 1. Authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose—in what amount—to be submitted to the legal voters of said city.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the common council of the city of Minneapolis, is hereby authorized and empowered to pass an ordinance or ordinances issuing the bonds of said city at any time within one year from the passage of this act, to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, to assist in the preservation of the Falls of St. Anthony, by the construction of an apron, or the erection of a dam, or any other means that may be decided by said council to be

best adapted to such end, and to regulate by such ordinance or ordinances the terms upon which such bonds shall be appropriated to such end, *Provided*, That no such ordinance shall (have) validity or force until ratified by a majority of the legal voters of said city of Minneapolis voting at an election to be called by said city council, due notice of which election shall be given, and said council shall have full power to regulate by ordinance, the time and manner of holding any such election upon any such ordinance.

## CHAPTER LXXXIV.

February 12, 1868

*An Act to authorize the city of Minneapolis, to issue Bonds for the construction of Water Works.*

SECTION 1. Authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose.

2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.

3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

To issue bonds

SECTION 1. That the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said city to an amount not exceeding forty thousand dollars to run such number of years and of such denominations, and to draw such rate of interest not exceeding ten per cent. per annum as the common council of said city may by resolution prescribe, for the purpose of constructing the water works of said city, and providing the necessary apparatus for extinguishing fire.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.
