SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XCIX.

An Act authorizing the board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County to levy a special tax to defray the expenses of the Court of Common Pleas of said County.

March 4, 1868.

SECTION 1. County Commissioners authorized to levy an annual tax for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Court of Common Pleas.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To levy a tax—
for what purpose.

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the court of common pleas of Ramsey county, the board of county commissioners thereof is hereby authorized and directed to levy annually hereafter, at the time of levying the general taxes of said county, a special tax of one mill on each dollar of the valuation of the taxable property in said county, such tax to be placed upon the lists and collected in the same manner as the other taxes of Ramsey county.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
