## CHAPTER XXXI.

March 5, 1869. An Act to amend Section twelve, Chapter twenty-nine, General Statutes, relating to alteration or vacation of towns.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section twelve (12), Chapter twonty-nine (20), General Statutes. District Court may alter or vacate towns.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[Section 1.]

Sec. 12. The district courts are authorized and empowered, upon application made by one or more of the proprietors of any city or town, or of any addition to any city or town, or of any part of any city or town, or addition thereto, within this district, to alter or vacate the same, or any part thereof, including streets and public squares, and to adjudge and declare the title to such streets, alleys and public squares in such persons as are entitled to the same.
