

CHAPTER XXXIV.

An Act to amend Section one hundred and thirty-four of Chapter eight of the General Statutes, relating to the duties of County Treasurers.

March 5, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section one hundred and thirty-four (134) of Chapter eight (8) of the General Statutes. Settlement between Auditor and Treasurer —when to be made.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and thirty-four of chapter eight of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 134. The county treasurer shall on the last day of February, the fifteenth day of June and the tenth day of October, in each year, make settlement with the auditor of the county, and on the fifteenth day of March, and the first day of November, in each year, the county treasurer shall send by express from the nearest public express office, to the state treasurer, all moneys by him received for state purposes, according to the last certificate of his settlement with the auditor of his county, and the state auditor is hereby authorized to draw upon any county treasurer in favor of the treasurer of state, for any moneys in the county treasury belonging to the state, at any time after the June settlement in each year, as herein provided for; and the county treasurer shall pay such drafts to an amount equal to the June certificate of settlement with the auditor of his county, and the state treasurer shall give duplicate receipts for the money so paid, one of which he shall deposit with the state auditor; and the county treasurer is hereby required to pay over to any town, city or school district treasurer any money found to be in the county treasury at either of the within named settlements, belonging to any town, city, road or special school fund, or other

fund, in the manner required by law, and to take duplicate receipts therefor, one of which he shall transmit by mail, on or before the fifteenth day of March next thereafter, to the clerk or recorder of the town, city or school district, to which treasurer the money is paid, which receipt shall be filed and safely kept by said clerk or recorder in his office.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXV.

March 2, 1869.

An Act to amend Section fifty-six of Chapter eleven, of the General Statutes, in relation to the duties of County Auditors.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section fifty-six (56) of Chapter eleven (11) of the General Statutes. Auditor to keep account with each township, city, village or school district, and give order on Treasurer for taxes collected due each.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section fifty-six of chapter eleven of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 56. The county auditor shall open an account with each township, city, incorporated village or school district in his county, in which immediately after his semi-annual settlement with the county treasurer in each year, he shall credit each township, city, or incorporated village, or school district with the net amount so collected for the use of any such township, village or school district, and upon application of any town, city, village or school treasurer, the auditor shall give him an order on the county treasurer for the amount due such township, city,
