said order shall be accompanied by a certificate from the secretary of the Minnesota state agricultural society, to the effect that such county society has, prior to the tenth day of July preceding such appropriation, made a report to the said secretary of the state agricultural society, of their transactions of the year previous.

An Act to amend Chapter twenty-two of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, relating to foreign and domestic Insurance Companies.

- Section 1. Amendment to Section one (1) of Chapter twenty-two (22) of the General Laws of 1868. Statement to be filed in the office of State Treasurer with a written agreement—what agreement to contain.
 - Amendment to Section two (2) of said Chapter. Foreign insurance companies to pay two per cent. on all premiums annually.
 - 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota':

Where to file

Section 1. That section one, of chapter twenty-two of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, approved March seventh, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, be amended by adding the following: Such statement shall be filed in the office of the said treasurer, together with a written agreement, under the seal of the company, signed by the president and secretary thereof, and agreeing upon the part of the company, that service of process in any civil action against such company, may be made upon any agent of the company in this state, and authorizing such agent, for and in be-

half of such company, to admit such service of process upon him and agreeing that the service of process upon any agent shall be valid and binding upon the company,

as if made upon the president or secretary thereof.

That the proviso of section two, of said chapter, relating to a two per cent. tax, be amended so as to To pay two per read as follows: Provided, further, All foreign insurance cent on premicompanies doing business in this state, under the provis-taxes. ions of this act, shall annually, at the time the certificate of authority is granted, pay to the treasurer of state two per cent, on all premiums received in cash, and other obligations, except what are denominated insurance deposit notes, representing dividends of the company, by their agents or attorneys in this state during the year ending on the preceding thirty-first day of December, which sum shall be paid into the general revenue fund, and shall be in lieu of all other taxes to be collected from said companies in this state.

This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to and after its passage.

SECTION 1. That the salary of the deputy warden be salary of deputy and hereby is fixed at the sum of one thousand dollars Prison. per annum.
